1. **Pronunciation**

2. Spelling

The research result can be concluded that spelling errors significantly affect students' understanding of the meaning of word in a text. Students feel confused and often misinterpret the meaning of words when they spell them incorrectly. To overcome these difficulties, students use various strategies such as rewriting difficult words, using dictionaries, or applications to assist with spelling they also emphasize the importance of regular spelling practice, which not only helps them remember and understand new vocabulary but also boosts their confidence when writing complex words in English.

3. Meaning

It can be concluded that the most students have difficulty using words whose meaning they do not understand. However, they agreed that context was very helpful in understanding, because by looking at the use of words in they could guess or understand the meaning of the sentence better. Impact on learning motivation: Difficult and length words also contribute to a decline in students' motivation to learn. they tend to feel frustrated, stressed, and less interested in studying these words when they encounter significant difficulties in pronunciation or comprehension. 4. Coping strategies used: some students attempt to overcome these challenges by breaking down long words into smaller parts or syllables, which makes it easier for them to memorize and understand these words.

Overall, this study highlights that the length and complexity of English words are significant factors contributing to students' learning difficulties, requiring special attention in the teaching process

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DISCUSSSION

First, Students' responses reflect a significant impact of pronunciation on their vocabulary learning process. Most students mentioned that incorrect pronunciation often leads to misunderstanding the meaning of words. They also noted that difficulty in pronouncing new word decreases their willingness to use or learn those words. The fear of mispronunciation, and consequently being ridiculed, lowers their confidence in speaking English, especially in public or classroom settings. These findings highlight that pronunciation errors not only affect comprehension but also influence students' motivation and confidence in using English.

Students indicated that correct spelling is closely tied to their ability to learn and remember new vocabulary efficiently. Challenges with complex spellings often require students to repeatedly write the words, use tools like dictionary or apps, and engage in consistent spelling practice improves students' confidence and mastery over difficult words, suggesting that focus on spelling accuracy could enhance overall vocabulary acquisition.

Understanding the meaning of words proved to be a crucial factor in vocabulary retention and usage. Students expressed that if they do not grasp the meaning of a word, they struggle to use it correctly in conversations. Contextual clues, such as sentence usage or accompanying images, play a significant role in helping students decipher meaning. However, when students encounter words with similar meanings, they often face confusion and require additional strategies like comparing definitions, using synonyms, or seeking visual aids to differentiate between them. This emphasizes the need for a contextualized approach to teaching vocabulary to improve comprehension.

The length and complexity of words pose significant challenges for students. Long and complex words tend to overwhelm them, slowing down their learning process and making it difficult for them to retain the vocabulary. Students reported that breaking down longer words into smaller, manageable parts help with memorization.
